

CÔD GWISG Y CHWECHED DOSBARTH

DRESS CODE FOR THE SIXTH FORMERS

- Mae hawl gan aelodau'r chweched i wisgo dillad o'u dewis i'r ysgol. Nid oes raid iddynt wisgo'r wisg ffurfiol fel gweddill yr ysgol. Ar yr un pryd, dylid sicrhau bod y wisg yn **addas i sefydliad addysgol**
- Dylai pob disgybl sicrhau nad yw'n gwisgo unrhyw beth allai dramgyddo neu frifo teimladau rhywun arall e.e. slogan ar grys.
- Dylai sgert neu drowsus byr fod o hyd gweddus – nid yn uwch na'r pen-glin (hyd yn oed gyda teits.)
- Ni chaniateir gwisgo capiau neu hwds o fewn yr adeilad. Dylid tynnu côt mewn gwers.
- Ni chaniateir colur, gemwaith, lliw neu steil gwalt eithafol.
- Ni ddylai topiau ddangos gormod o gnawd, dim 'crop tops'. Dim jîns wedi ei rwygo'n ormodol.
- Dylai esgidiau fod yn rhai call e.e. dim sodlau uchel.

Enghreifftiau nodwyd uchod. Bydd hawl gan Bennaeth y Chweched ofyn i ddisgybl addasu ei wisg os yw'n teimlo ei bod yn anaddas. Mewn achosion difrifol iawn, byddwn yn anfon y disgybl adref i newid.

- Students in the sixth form are permitted to wear clothes of their own choice to school. They are not expected to wear the same uniform as the rest of the school. However, their dress must be **suitable for an educational establishment.**
- Students must ensure that their clothes aren't offensive in any way, e.g. a slogan on a T-shirt.
- Skirts and shorts must be of a decent length – no higher than the knee (even with tights).
- Caps and hoods should not be worn inside the building. Coats should not be worn in class.
- Extreme makeup, jewellery, hairstyles and hair colours are not permitted.
- Tops should not reveal too much flesh. No crop tops please.
- Shoes should be suitable and sensible, e.g. no high heels.

The above are only examples. The Head of the Sixth Form has a right to ask a student to correct or modify their dress if perceived unsuitable. In extreme cases, students will be sent home to change.
