Welsh Baccalaureate Skills Challenge Certificate





In years 10 and 11, you will complete the Skills Challenge Certificate. The Skills Challenge Certificate includes 4 different Challenges, each one focusing on a range of different skills.

Global Citizenship Challenge

In the Global Citizenship Challenge, you will research a topic that has an impact on the word, e.g. global warming. You will learn about the topic, research, and consider how to solve the global problem. This Challenge accounts for 15% of the Skills Challenge Certificate.

What will I do during this Challenge?

- 1. Read sources and gather information.
- 2. Consider PESTLE factors Political, Economical, Social, Technological, Legal, Environmental.
- 3. Write a Personal Standpoint (800 words).
- 4. Raise awareness pack.



Community Challenge

In the Community Challenge, you will focus on real concerns and needs by planning and doing activities that aim to make a difference in the community. This Challenge accounts for 15% of the Skills Challenge Certificate.

What will I do during this Challenge?

- 1. Plan your activity for the community.
- 2. Complete 10 hours of community work with the aim of improving part of the community.
- 3. Reflect on the process.
- *You can work as an individual or in a group of 3-6 people.



Enterprise and Employability Challenge

In the Enterprise and Employability Challenge, you will be working on a brief for a specific audience. You will need to design a suitable product considering different factors. This Challenge accounts for 20% of the Skills Challenge Certificate.

What will I do during this Challenge?

- 1. Develop an idea for a product.
- 2. SWOT analysis and hold meetings in your groups.
- 3. Consider the '5Ps' in business Product, Price, Place, People, Promotion).
- 4. Present the product to a panel.
- 5. Reflect on the process.
- *Working in a group of 3-6 people.

Individual Project

The **Individual Project** is an essay of 1000 to 2000 words on a topic of your choice. You will need to think about aims and objectives, your research methods, create a questionnaire and gather information from different sources to answer your question. You will complete the Project in year 11. This Challenge accounts for 50% of the Skills Challenge Certificate.

What will I do during this Challenge?

- 1. Set a question as the title of your work.
- 2. Set goals and objectives.
- 3. Complete the aims and objectives by completing a questionnaire and finding information from different types of sources.
- 4. Answer the question.
- 5. Evaluate your work.
